14. OTHER IMPORTANT ACTIVITIES:

- On the request of Assam Forest Department, Dr. Pankaj K. Aggarwal and Dr. Shakti Singh Chauhan visited Tinsukia, Assam from 26-28 August 2019 to discuss about feasibility of establishing wood processing units like wood seasoning plant/s and wood treatment plant/s at Tinsukia, Assam.
- The institute organized monthly seminar for the research staff and students of IWST on the theme "Forensic Discrimination of *Dalbergia* Timber - An Integrated Approach". The presentations were Wood Anatomy by Dr. M. Sujatha, Chemical Profiling by Dr. Rakesh Kumar, NIR Spectroscopy by Dr. S. R. Shukla and DNA Barcoding by Ms. Tresa Hamalton.
